APPEARANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE

Meeting Minutes for June 11th, 2019

Committee Members present: Paul Mocogni, Paul Jaimes, Dan Wertheimer, Ben Ellis

Committee Members absent: John Cioni

City staff present: Dustin Anand

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

Approval of Minutes: Minutes from May 28, 2019 were presented for approval. Motion to accept by Mocogni, seconded by Ellis. Motion carried with all in favor.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

Brian Carman, representing Teddy O'Brian's presented a new signage proposal.

Paul Mocogni inquired as to the number of neon signs that were currently present at the building, and Brian confirmed there was one per façade.

The committee discussed that the plans represent a significant improvement over the current green awning, and as presented, are aligned with city code.

Dan Wertheimer proposed a passing a recommendation to approve, which was seconded by Ellis. Motion was carried with all in favor.

2. Barbara Soriano, representing RapidServ presented a proposal for window signage. This includes a listing, at eye level of some of the services offered. There is one neon "open" sign.

Committee discussed the facts that: a) the legal business' name does not communicate the nature of the services offered, and b) when cars are parked in the spaces at the front of the business, the lower portions of the window are obscured. Additionally, the building is set back from the street. For these reasons, the committee recommends a variance to: 10-3-6-7 B1(a) – listing of goods and services not permitted – variance based upon 10-3-9-A1(a)-4 – unique circumstances.

Committee recommends approval, but conditional upon:

- a) The old (empty) box sign on the façade must be removed prior to installation of new signage and
- b) It was not apparent from the plans provided whether the lettering on the business phone signage is 4" or less. If it is greater than 4" the size should be amended.

The motion was proposed by Ellis, seconded by Jaimes, and carried with all in favor.

3. Eric Falberg, representing 28 Mile Vodka presented a proposal for sidewalk seating.

Ben Ellis inquired as to whether this would risk obstructing sidewalk access. Eric explained that the area where they would be situated is set 5' back from the street, and so the sidewalk would remain clear to pedestrian traffic.

Paul Mocogni shared the new guidelines for outdoor seating areas. These were reviewed, and all agreed that the seating proposed was in line with the guidelines. There will be 10 tables, with seating. Umbrellas, fencing and planters are not part of this proposal.

Jaimes proposed a recommendation to approve, Wertheimer seconded and the motion was passed with all in favor.

OTHER BUSINESS FROM ARC AND CITY STAFF

Paul Mocogni welcomed new Committee members, Paul Jaimes and Dan Wertheimer. Dustin Anand will arrange for them to be provided with full copies of relevant City Code and guidelines.

The next meeting will be June 25th.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:54 pm. Motion to adjourn was made by Mocogni and seconded by Wertheimer.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm

Approval of Minutes:

Minutes from June 11, 2019 were not discussed as a quorum from that meeting was not present.

SCHEDULED BUSINESS:

- 1. Life & Death, 51 Highwood Avenue. Lydia Backer, owner, presented plans for a window signage. Window sign "Life & Death" would be 3-color removal decal, approximately 5 5/8 in. x 30 in. displayed up to 4 feet above windowsill on interior window. A "51" address sign would be in 5-inch white decal lettering above door. A motion to recommend approval of the window signage as presented was made by Cioni and seconded by Gonzales. Motion carried with all in favor.
- 2. Doris Bridal, 448 Sheridan Road. Jack Wykel, owner, presented plans for a façade renovation. Renovation includes removal of mansard roof, removal of existing signs, removal of cedar block behind front roof, installation of some new brick to match existing brick, installation of steel on top of wall and installation of new sign with goose neck lighting. New sign would appear on northeast portion of façade and would be HDU carved PVC 72 in. x 72 in. with 2 panels 15" x 62" "Traycee Home Care" sign and 28" x 60" "Doris Bridal Service" sign. Black satin finish goose neck LED light would appear above sign panels. Hours of operation in maximum 4-inch lettering would appear on door. Traycee Home Care currently displays a listing of goods and services on one window panel; if plans include keeping this listing, this must be presented for ARC approval. A motion to recommend approval of façade changes and signage, other than good and services signage, was made by Jaimes and seconded by Gonzales. Motion carried with all in favor.

OTHER BUSINESS FROM ARC AND CITY STAFF:

Old business: There was a brief discussion of removal of paper signage at RapidServe.

New business: There was a brief discussion of possible clean-up of exterior and fixing of pothole at Walgreens.

Next meeting is scheduled for September 10, 2019.

With no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:42 pm. Motion to adjourn was made by Cioni and seconded by Jaimes.
