TOT BALL

AGES: 4 & 5 Year Olds **WHEN:** Monday Evenings **DATES:** May 4 thru July 20

TIMES: Various between 4:30 and 6:45

The first 3 weeks are used as an introduction on how to field, throw, running the bases and hit. The children are then divided into teams and begin to play actual games with a soft bat and ball with a coach pitching to them. We will also use a hitting tee occasionally as an aid for teaching the children how to hit.

This league still focuses on the fundamentals but our main goal is to make sure the children are having a good time playing the game of baseball. Our coaches still pitch in this league. The pitches come in a little harder and a little faster but our philosophy does not change. There are more opportunities for hitting and fielding the ball under these conditions than in a player pitch format, keeping each child involved throughout the game.
