ORDINANCE NO. 2009-0-_____
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLE CODE
OF 1975 TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON EUCLID COURT AND ADJOINING CUL-
DE-SAC

WHEREAS, The Traffic and Motor Vehicle Code of 1975 (City of Highwood Ordinance Number 70-0-15), Section 12-103 lists the streets within the City of Highwood where parking is prohibited, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Highwood has determined that the best interests of the City will be attained by placing the same limitation upon the parking of vehicles of both sides of Euclid Court including any part of adjoining cul-de-sac, and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Vehicle Code grants a city council the power to regulate the parking of vehicles (625 ILCS 5/11-208(a)1);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIGHWOOD, Lake County, Illinois:

SECTION ONE: Section 12-103(i) of the Traffic and Motor Vehicle Code of 1975, as amended, which regulates the parking of motor vehicles on certain places is hereby further amended by adding subsection 26 to read as follows:

12. EUCLID COURT both sides including any part of adjoining cul-de-sac.

SECTION TWO: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be applied in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
